In her studio, she works as a visual and digital artist, graphic/web designer, illustrator, animator, photographer and marketing consultant. Lisa has successfully served many clients and agencies in North America.

In 2020, Lisa began a residency with the White Water Gallery in North Bay, ON. She is currently working on a solo exhibition for their 2020 / 2021 season. Lisa is the winner of two 1st Place Awards for works featured in juried group exhibitions. Lisa enjoys sharing her skills and knowledge with others. Over the years, Lisa has instructed various professional development workshops for artists and businesses in her community. Since 2019, she has been a workshop instructor for The Artfix / Workman Arts Program. In 2016, Lisa instructed a Typography course for Canadore College's Graphic Design Program in North Bay, ON.

Lisa is an experienced and talented Assistant Art Director. She has worked for many TV and Film productions in Northern Ontario including; Carter - Season 2, The Trickster and several Hallmark features. For over 20 years Lisa traveled extensively as a touring musician, playing harmonica and singing with various Canadian bands.

Artist Statement

Time pushes us all forward, and we carry on, retaining all that we have experienced, like a leaf floating on a river full of unexpected rapids and quiet periods of calm, deep water.

Lisa Duhaime-Gibson's mixed-media collages, illustrations & animations combine imagery, video, atmospheric sounds and recycled materials to bring us into her own story and breathe life into her art.

Lisa uses multi-media disciplines to create moments in time that provoke a deeply emotional reaction, as we recognize our own stories within these images. Lisa's work often reveals the complexity of being a woman and brings awareness to mental health and domestic abuse issues. This life we all share, though sometimes riddled with darkness, is also brilliant. It is our frailty, vulnerability and courage that make us all human, and that is beautiful.
